Each game will consist of two 30 minute halves with a ten minute halftime. Games end at the end of regulation regardless if there is a tie.

Each team will provide two ball boys per game for one time slot (6 total ball boys). For games where two teams are signed up, we will have a total of 4 ball boys per game; games with only one team signed up will have a total of 2 ball boys per game. Every team will only have one ball boy time slot with the exception of Hoopeston teams who will cover the first and last time slots on Saturday and Sunday. This will help officials to keep the games going, and limit any long breaks in the games for players. **Coaches are responsible for having set of ball boys report to EACH game's officials ten minutes prior to kick off. I will be providing a ball bag with five game balls for the varsity field only for the weekend. Coaches when it is your teams turn to be ball boys, they need to have 10 balls (5 at the practice field and 5 football field). In games where there are 4 ball boys, we will have a game ball and a ball with each ball boy. On games where there are only two ball boys, besides a game ball and each ball boy having a ball, a ball will be placed at each goal. It is the ball boys responsibility to collect the balls on the varsity field to collect the five balls and return them to the bag. The ball boys on the other two fields need to collect their game balls and return them back to their team.**

This year we were able to set the schedule so that no Varsity team would have to play a back-to-back game and therefore reduced the down time between each round of games. As there will only be on average 15-20 minutes from one game ending to the next one starting, teams waiting to play next are advised to begin stretches off the field to allow proper time to warmup as there will not be much time to do so between games.
