

The staff at Maple School would like to introduce you to our behavior program. It is called: Positive Behavior Intervention and Support (PBIS). Our PBIS program is a comprehensive set of expectations that define behaviors in all settings. Our expectations are: Be Safe, Be Respectful and Be Responsible. These expectations are taught to all students and staff and are posted throughout the building. As this is a district wide initiative, you will see these expectations throughout the district and community. We hope this creates a common language of appropriate actions and reactions.

After PBIS expectations are taught to our students, a conscious effort is made by all staff to acknowledge students who choose to follow the expectations through a system of praise and rewards. At Maple School, we use Class Dojo. It is a website that awards students points for being safe, respectful, and responsible. Students are expected to have 85% positive points monthly and quarterly to earn rewards and to participate in celebrations.
